The Purpose of M.O.U. is with reference to exploring the areas of cooperation, benefiting both the Institute and the Industry.


Areas of cooperation

This Memorandum/Agreement is not a contract. This memorandum/Agreement serves only as a statement of the general intention of the parties and is not intended to be legally binding nor to be construed as an agreement on any matters mentioned. No oral agreement or conduct of the parties(including partial performance) in respect of matters stated in this Memorandum/Agreement shall be deemed to impose any obligation of liability on either party.

This memorandum / Agreement is not intended to constitute , create, give effect to, of otherwise form a joint venture, or other business entity of any kind . Neither party shall act as an agent for, or parte of, the other party. There are neither any right nor obligation of the parties established under this Memorandum/Agreement.

VI.

Although the intention of this Memorandum/Agreement is to discuss and negotiate issues with respect to a possible definitive agreement between the parties, the relationship is non-exclusive, and the parties shall have the ability to form similar or different business relationship with other companies of entities of their choice.

VII

All publication resulting from the collaboration between the two institution must give recognition to the memorandum/Agreement . Likewise, the Memorandum/Agreement must also be mentioned in all courses and formal presentation that result from collaboration under the terms here of.

Should any faculty collaboration result in any potential for intellectual property, the parties will immediately meet through designated representative and seek an equitable and fair understanding as to ownership and other property interests that may arise. Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is entered into on this 10th July, 2021 by and between **I.C.S. College of Arts, Commerce & Science, Khed, Dist. Ratnagiri** and **S. P. Hegshetye College of Arts, Commerce and Science, Ratnagiri**. I.C.S. College of Arts, Commerce & Science, Khed, Dist. Ratnagiri and S. P. Hegshetye College of Arts, Commerce and Science, Ratnagiri agree that cooperation in student and faculty exchanges would be mutually beneficial. The areas of cooperation may include, subject to mutual consent, any desirable and feasible activity that would further the goals of each institution. Such interaction may include cooperation in a variety of joint academic and educational activities such as:

ARTICLE 1: SCOPE OF COLLABORATION

1. Joint conferences and workshops;
2. Team taught courses, including online courses;
3. Visits by faculty, professional staff, and students;
4. Studies in various disciplines;
5. Inter-disciplinary and multi-disciplinary studies.
6. Conduct practical training on Entrepreneurship Development.

The parties anticipate that a number of these initiatives will occur during the period of this MOU. However, neither party is obligated to agree to any minimum number of activities, nor is this MOU intended to preclude either party from entering into similar agreements with other institutions. The following initiatives provide good starting places and can be implemented as soon as administrative details are agreed upon between the two institutions:

ARTICLE 2: DURATION AND EVALUATION

2.1 This MOU shall be in effect for a period of 3 years from the last date of signature. Either party may request termination of this agreement, in writing, ninety (90) days prior to the proposed termination date. Termination of this MOU shall not affect activities in progress pursuant to specific activity agreements, which shall continue until concluded by the parties in accordance with their terms or as otherwise agreed to by the parties in writing. Any activities in progress at the time of termination shall be permitted to conclude as planned unless otherwise agreed in writing.

2.2 A joint evaluation of the MOU will be initiated by the designated representatives six (6) months prior to the expiration date. Following the evaluation, the MOU may be renewed and resigned for an additional five (5) year period.

2.3 Amendments to this MOU may be requested, in writing, by either party and approved by the authorized signatories.

Whereas ICSC college with the vision to educate, earner and empower to rural India since June 1998. To generate the social mind set amongst students and as social reasonability, the collage has established NSS and NCC units for serving duty for society through various social and outreach activities. College has also established Women's Hostell, Central Library, Gymkhana, In-door Training Centre independent Buildings from the grants received by University Grants Commission (UGC) to enhance infrastructure facility for upcoming generation. At present 1400 students are facilitated by Higher Education. In Arts, Commerce, Science as well as IT & Management faculties. ISCS students are actively participating in various cultural Activities at Zonal Level. University Level State and State Level every year and won Folk Dance competition at University Level. Students of ICSC are acting in media industry like film industry and TV serials. NSS student Miss. Shveta Tame honored Best NSS Volunteer Indira Gandhi National Award by the hands of Hon'ble President of India at Rashtrapati Bhawan, New Delhi in last NAAC accreditation in 2012 our college accredited with 'B' grade. Keeping in mind these achievements and objectives the ICSC is continuously endeavoring for betterment of the students and all other stakeholders.

Whereas the VNSS is a leading NGO having its objective to conserve the natural environment by planting the trees and caring the wilds with in rural communities, enabling them to restore their environment, to create awareness and educate students by developing a chain of volunteers. It has conducted several workshops and undertaken research projects. Organised exhibitions, slide shows and lectures in villages as well as school & colleges. VNSS has its wild rescue team which is continuously working to carry various rescue operations to protect wild animals and birds.

Both these parties of the memorandum have engaged themselves voluntarily in the field of environment, education and its conservation. And hence both have put hands together to spread awareness about the conservation, protection and to spread importance of environment through students' participation. Therefore it has agreed between the parties to execute this Memorandum of Understanding.

NOW IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED BY BOTH THE PARTIES BY MEMORUND OF UNDERSTANDING AS UNDER:

A) The Statement of Objectives-

1. Intended to have collaboration between the ICSC and VNSS for joint efforts in the area of environment conservation.
2. To plan and execute tree plantation programmes, biodiversity charts preparation and exhibition in Konkan and rest of India. It is also agreed to spread awareness about the protection and to spread education about the environment among the present and future generations of the nation.
3. Furthermore to have inclusive participation from students as well as teachers and other stakeholders of from the society.
4. Furthermore to have inclusive participation from students as well as teachers and other stakeholders from society.
5. One of the objective is to carry research projects to inculcate research values among the students and to contribute towards environment protection.
6. Motivate students to volunteer for social cause and to encourage them to participate in the various activities for protection of environment.
7. To inculcate good habits among the students like planting trees, keeping surrounding clean and adopting eco-friendly life style as well as making effective use of technology to protect the environment etc.

B) Execution-

1. It has been agreed that at least three to four activities to be undertaken in a year in relation to objectives on collaborative basis between both the parties.
2. The ICSC shall organize lectures of experts from the VNSS regarding protection of the environment and also to spread awareness among the students about importance of environment.
3. The experts from the VNSS will rendered guidance to the students from the ICSC for environment related activities.
4. With joint collaboration of VNSS under the guidance of their experts tree plantation & conservation Programme to be undertaken from the students yearly.
5. The ICSC will provide students volunteers for tree plantation and other activities of the VNSS.

C) Financial Obligations-

1. The VNSS shall provide optimum funds to carry out tree plantation.
2. The experts from VNSS shall be entitled for honorarium as per the University of Mumbai norms. An experts of VNSS will guide the students in their academic projects with reference to natural environment concern.
3. The VNSS and the ICSC shall bear the transportation expenses equally.

4. With reference to research projects, ICSC and VNSS share equal responsibilities including financial contribution.

D) Liability for Default-

1. The ICSC shall not be responsible for criminal acts of participation.

2. In case any mishap or accident during travelling or any planned event/activity. The ICSC and VNSS shall not be liable to pay any compensation to the students or family members and also to take undertaking.

3. It shall be responsibility of the ICSC to make their students aware of these rules of this Memorandum of understanding.

4. The ICSC will take responsibility to instruct their students to maintain the discipline when the events and activities are to be carried on.

5. The objective of this memorandum of Understanding is not to make any profit, so no legal action shall lie for any loss or profit or other monetary damage.
