## INFORMATION OF PROFESSIONAL COURSES BACHELOR OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY [B. Sc.] (I.T.)

In affiliation to University of Mumbai, the department of Information Technology was established in the academic year 2001-2002 and stand the subject of Information Technology at 10+2 level in year 2008-2009. Today, the department offers the UG Course of advanced syllabus. Department has experienced and qualified in house teaching staff. Lectures of visiting faculty are also arranged depending upon need. Students are given project work, hardware training and much more.

### Eligibility

- A candidate for being eligible for admission to the degree course of Bachelor of Science Information Technology, shall have passed XII standard examination of the Maharashtra Board of Higher Secondary Education or it's equivalent with Mathematic and Statistics as one of the subject and should have secured not less than 45% marks in aggregate for open category and 40% marks in aggregate in case of Reserved category candidates. ( Passed in First Attempt)
- Candidate who have passed Diploma (Three years after S.S.C.-Xth Std.) in Information Technology/Computer Technology/Computer Engineering/Computer Science/Electrical, Electronics and Video Engineering and Allied Branches/ Mechanical and Allied Branches/ Civil and Allied branches are eligible for direct admission to the Second year of the B.Sc. (IT) degree course. However, the Diploma should be recognized by the Board of Technical Education or any other recognized Government Body. Minimum marks required 45% aggregate for open category candidates and 40% aggregate for reserved category candidates.

### OR

Candidates with post HSC-Diploma in Information Technology/Computer Technology/ Computer Engineering / Computer Science / and Allied Branches will be eligible for direct admission to the second year of B.Sc. (IT). However, the Diploma should be recognized by the Board of Technical Education or any other recognized Government Body. Minimum Marks required 45% aggregate for open category candidates and 40% aggregate for reserved category candidates.

## Library

The spacious Library has a vast collection of nearly 10,000 Text Books & Reference Books. In addition a number of periodicals and as many as 12 news papers and fifty Journals / Periodicals in different languages are subscribed for. Xerox facility is also made available for students on payment basis, Well ventilate, well-lit reading hall is available to students desirous of doing Reading/Reference work. Book Bank facility is provided to deserving and needy students.

### LIBRARY RULES :-

1. The library remains open from 8.30 a.m. to 6.00 p.m.
2. Every student must be in possession of an Identity Card.
3. Students will be issued Borrower's Ticket and Reader's Ticket on submission of: (1) Current Fee receipt and (2) Two latest passport size photographs.
4. Every student must get the Identity Card and Borrower's Ticket within 15 days after the date of admission. After 15 days he will be fined Rs. 5.00 per day.
5. Loss of I.C. or Borrower's Ticket or Readers Ticket must be reported in writing. Duplicate Identity Card or Borrower's Ticket will be reissued after a week at a charge of Rs. 25/-
6. Normally a book is lent for home reading to a maximum period of seven days on Borrower's Ticket.
7. The student should fill the slip for the desired books one day in advance. On the availability of the books. The Library will issue them as per priority.
8. All student are advised to check the books issued to them and bring to the notice of the library staff any discrepancy they come across (such as missing pages). No complaints will be entertained afterwards.
9. Books will be issued against Reader's Ticket for only one day i.e. between 8.30 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. or over night. Students will not be permitted to take the book out of the Library.
10. The students who desire to take advantage of the book bank facility should fill in the printed form available in the College Library. Books are then issued to deserving students on a nominal deposit after consisting the following points.
11. Keep Silence is the cardinal principle in and around the Library.

## Anti Ragging Act 1999

The Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act 1999. Act of Maharashtra legislature received the assent of the Governor on 15th May, 1999 & was published in Maharashtra Govt. Gazette.

Prohibition of ragging (sec 3) : Ragging within or outside the educational institute is prohibited. Penalty (sec4) : Whoever directly or indirectly commits ragging, participates in , abets or propagates ragging within or outside any educational institute shall on conviction, be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend to two years & shall be liable to fine which may extend to Rs. 10,000/-rupees.

Dismissal (sec5) : Any Student convicted of offence under sec4 penalty for ragging shall ne dismissed from the educational institute & such student shall not be admitted in any other educational institution for a period of 5 years from the date of the order of such dismissal.

Suspension (sec6) :

1) Whenever any student or as the case may be, the parent or guardian, or a teacher of an educational institution complaints, in writing, of ragging to the head of the educational institution, the head of that educational institution shall, without prejudice of the forgoing provisions within seven days of the receipt of the complaint & if, prima facie, it is found true suspend the student who is accused of the offence & shall, immediately forward the complaint to the police station having the jurisdiction over the area in which the educational institution is situated, for further action. 2) Where, on inquiry by the head of the educational institution is proved that there is no substance, prima facie, in the complaint received under the sub section (1). 3) The decision of the head of the educational institution that the student has indulged in ragging under the sub section (1) shall be final.

## Refund Fees

0.2859 : Refund of Tuition, Development and all other fees after cancellation of admission. The candidates who have taken admission in undergraduate courses in Government colleges, in Govt. aided and in aided courses conducted by affiliated colleges and recognized institutions may request for refund of fees after applying in writing for cancellation of their admission to the course. The refund of fees as applicable shall be made on the 30th day after the date of cancellation. The percentage of fee for the course which shall be refunded to the candidate after deducting charges as follows :

The total amount considered for the refund of fees from the commencement of academic term of the courses includes the following :

- All the fee items chargeable for one year as per relevant University circulars for different faculties (excluding the courses for which the total amount is fixed by other competent authorities).
- The fee charge towards group insurance and all fee component to be paid as University share (including vice chancellor fund, University fee for sports & cultural activities, each are disaster management fund, exam fee & enrollment fee) are non refundable if payment is made by the college prior to the date of cancellation.
- Fee collected for identity card & library card, admission form and prospectus, enrollment and any other course specific fee are not refundable after the commencement of the academic term.
- All refundable deposits (Laboratory, Caution money and Library, etc.) shall be fully returned at the time of commencement.
- Wherever admissions are made through centralized admission process for professional and/or for any other courses by other competent Authorities of Government of Maharashtra, the Refund Rules are applicable as specified by such authorities (as per the rules of relevant agencies) for the 1st year admission and in case of admission to subsequent years of the course. 0.2859 is applicable for cancellation of admission.

All fees paid by a student at the time of admission shall be refunded to him after deduction Rs. 250/- (Rupees Two Hundred and Fifty) as administrative charges. Provided : at the time of applying for admission, he intimates in writing that he has also applied or intends to apply for admission to some other courses too, in one or more colleges or institutions or departments of this university which impart instruction for courses of the University.

And

He/She withdraws his/her application in writing, within seven days from the date of his/her admission to college or course, but not later than 31st August of the same academic year. In such cases it shall be binding on the student to produce documentary proof of his/her being admitted to some other course of different college/institution. All fees paid by a student at the time of admission shall be refunded to him/her after deducting a lumpsum of Rs. 500/- (Rupees Five Hundred Only) as administrative charges. Provided : at the time of applying for admission he/she intimates in writing, that he/she has also applied or intends to apply for admission to one or more colleges or institutions or departments of this University which impart instruction for courses of the University.
